POSTLUDE Prelude in F Major Fanny Mendelssohn Hensel

In honor of United Women In Faith Sunday, today's organ music is by women composers.

Though Florence Beatrice Price (1887-1953) was born in Little Rock, Arkansas, she spent the last 26 years of her life in Chicago. Educated at the New England Conservatory of Music, Price is known as one of the foremost African-American classical composers. Her works include symphonies, instrumental and choral works, and a not insignificant number of works for organ. A committed Christian, she often used themes from the African American Church in her compositions.

Despite being often overshadowed by her brother Felix Mendelssohn, Fanny Mendelssohn Hensel composed over 450 pieces of music. Some say that Fanny was more experimental in her compositions than her more conventional brother Felix, but they were both strongly influenced by the music of Ludwig van Beethoven. Her Prelude in F Major was written for her wedding to Wilhelm Hensel on October 3, 1829.
