In collaboration with Women's History Month, we feature music by women composers and/or hymnwriters today. **Christa Rakich** is a concert organist and educator. Bach's chorale variations. **Fanny Crosby**, an old-school hymnwriter, probably wrote the words to several of your favorite hymns. **Twila Paris** is a contemporary Christian musician.
