**LOOSE COINS AND SINGLES IN THE OFFERING PLATES WILL GO TO UMCOR-MIDDLE EAST**

In efforts to support Palestinians in places like the West Bank and the northern Galilee section of Israel where most Palestinian citizens of Israel live, UMCOR supports partners that serve marginal and vulnerable Palestinian communities. Grants have been given to Hope Secondary School. This school helps children and families affected by the war in Gaza. Grants have been given to Princess Basma Centre which has developed a telemedicine program for children with disabilities who are unable to get through checkpoints for appointments. Also, a grant to Al Quds Foundation provides counseling to children and youth in the Shufat Refugee Camp.
