WINGS has Emergency Safe Houses in Chicago and the suburbs, Transitional Housing for unemployed survivors and their children with refuge while they seek employment. WINGS apartments are distributed throughout the north and northwest suburbs and Permanent Housing for long-term and optional supportive services to physically or mentally disabled adults and their children. In efforts to support Palestinians in places like the West Bank and the northern Galilee section of Israel where most Palestinian citizens of Israel live, UMCOR supports partners that serve marginal and vulnerable Palestinian communities. Grants have been given to Hope Secondary School. This school helps children and families affected by the war in Gaza. Grants have been given to Princess Basma Centre which has developed a telemedicine program for children with disabilities who are unable to get through checkpoints for appointments. Also, a grant to Al Quds Foundation provides counseling to children and youth in the Shufat Refugee Camp. As we see on the news nightly there is much need for support.
