Current Needs - Disaster Relief Supplies: 5 gallon buckets with lids, 32-64 oz. bottles of liquid laundry detergent, 16-40 oz. bottles of liquid concentrate household cleaner, 16-34 oz. bottles of liquid dish soap, scrub brushes, heavy-duty trash bags (33-45 gallon sizes), kitchen gloves, work gloves. Sizes are important as they must all fit in a 5 gal. bucket. Your donations of one or several items are most appreciated. Put in collection bins marked MMDC.
