of the book by Bill Eddy, *Why We Elect Narcissists and Sociopaths - And How We Can Stop!* On Sunday mornings in October from 9 - 9:55 am in Pastor Eun-Hye's office. Monica Isaac, a Deacon in the Northern Illinois Conference, a Licensed Professional Counselor, Marriage and Family Therapist and trained mediator.
